- February 6** *Annual General Meeting and Progress Review*
followed by: *Processions, Plays & Ran Tan Tan'* - Jeremy Lodge introduces some lost Collingham traditions.
- March 13** *'Confessions of a Vulcan Bomber Pilot'*. Geoff Dyer shares his personal memories as a Vulcan captain, some humorous - others shocking and tragic, in a behind-the-scenes look at RAF life during the Cold War.
- April 10** *'Jesse Boot: An Ethical Entrepreneur'*. Sophie Clapp, Company Archivist at Boots UK presents an illustrated talk charting the life of Jesse Boot from his humble origins through his rise to Lord Trent of Nottingham.
- May 11** *Archaeology Day* - Community test pit dig at The Old Hall.
- July 3** *Collingham Village Walk* – a walk to discover Collingham's development alongside the Fleet. Led by Nigel Priestley. Evening event, time to be confirmed.
- September 4** *Researching Collingham's Past* - a series of mini-presentations from Society members.
- October 2** *'Footpads, Kings and Highwaymen'*: Historian Ian Morgan traces 34 miles of the old Great North Road through Nottinghamshire visiting the scenes of battles, the haunts of highwaymen, the sites of murder and much, much more.
- November 20** *'The Archaeology of Roman Nottinghamshire'*, a presentation by Dr Steve Malone of Trent and Peak Archaeology.
